

Hall of Fame Guidelines & Points Breakdown

Description:

Halls of Fame is a system to encourage new and dynamic programs and legislative from each of the hall councils. The system acts to incentivize high quality and engaging interaction between the hall councils and the residents.

Eligibility

A program is eligible for Hall of Fame points if it meets the following criteria.

- The Program was put on between August 22nd and December 15th
- The Program sheet was turned in between August 22nd and December 17th
 - Turned in to Ebone Smith (esmith97@vt.edu)
- A majority (minimum of 50%) of the responsibility for the Program fell to the hall council
